

One in 15 UK medical sector job seekers look abroad for work according to Jobs4Medical.co.uk

- **Foreign medical job postings increase by 100 per cent since this time last year**
- **New Zealand is most popular country followed by Australia, America and Ireland**

Out of the 520 foreign jobs available on the Website, 22 per cent are for Doctors, whilst a staggering 55.2 per cent are for Nursing positions.

These latest findings come after a report compiled by the Institute for Public Policy Research entitled 'Brits Abroad: Mapping the scale and nature of British emigration' – showed that every three minutes a British National leaves the UK to start a new life abroad. According to a recent feature on the BBC's Website, Australia and New Zealand are keen to recruit UK public service workers and the Jobs4Medical research shows that these are popular destinations, along with North America and Ireland.

to progress their careers. Perhaps the most alarming figure is the number of nurses that are looking to leave the UK – most likely the result of under-staffing, long hours and low pay.”

“The medical sector is becoming a global profession, attracting a pool of highly talented individuals, both in the UK and abroad. Medical workers are increasingly looking for jobs abroad, regardless of their nationality, which is certainly a new trend. This time last year we did not have any foreign medical sector jobs posted onto the site, and we can see the trend continuing in years to come,” Vicky Scott added.

The Website is updated daily with the latest medical sector positions from both individual medical organisations and job agencies looking to find and place the right medical professional – quickly and efficiently – and has an average of 100,000 unique visitors each month. Jobs4Medical is free to candidates and is one of the few sites that does not allow searching of their database, allowing the candidate to remain in control of the application process. Jobs4Medical also contains useful links to medical information including a medical dictionary link, relevant classified ads, has the option to advertise practices for sale, as well as various links of general interest.
